

Residency Verification

To continue receiving benefits from the Best Starts for Kids Child Care Subsidy Program, all applicants must verify their King County residency.

Documentation dated within the last six months must be uploaded to your online application via the family portal. Below is a list of accepted documents for verifying your residency.

Accepted Documentation

Applicants can provide ONE document from List A or TWO documents from List B

List A - choose ONE document to submit -	List B - choose TWO documents to submit -

Special Considerations

If you are experiencing homelessness, you will be asked to answer a Housing Affidavit/Attestation Statement in the application. This will include a link that will open a separate window with the third-party verification form, which can be completed by the individual providing short-term housing or by a community member who can verify your residency within King County.

Please ensure your documents are current and clear to avoid delays in your reauthorization process.
